

CAGC Support to Provincial Organizations

Rationale: The CAGC has invested time and resources into the question of regulation and recognizes the value of regulation to the development of our profession. However, given that regulation requires action at a provincial level and CAGC acts at a national level, the CAGC is not able to directly pursue the regulation of our profession in any given province. Notwithstanding, the CAGC will provide support to provincial organizations pursuing professional regulation, as outlined below. The Board liaison for provincial organizations will be the Regional Representative.

Financial Support:

Reimbursement of start-up fees for provincial organizations, up to a total amount of \$1500. This may include fees associated with incorporating a provincial association, and/or other reasonable fees at the discretion of the Board of Directors. Receipts may be submitted on a quarterly basis, to the regional representative, for review and approval by the Board on an item-by-item basis. Once approved, the CAGC expense reimbursement form is to be submitted to the Treasurer.

Non-Monetary Support:

The CAGC is willing to extend time-limited non-monetary support to provincial organizations. These may include things such as email/advertising access to the membership or use of space at the annual education conference. Non-monetary support requests are to be submitted to the Board of Directors for consideration.
